WELCOME



We are grateful to the entire Texas McCombs community of faculty, staff, employers, and alumni who have come together to support our MSF Class of 2023. This year, 91% of our students have secured job offers within six months of graduation, with an average starting salary of \$82,198—a notable increase of 15.4% since 2020.

Our career management team has effectively tailored our MS career curriculum and programming to align with the shifting dynamics of the recruiting landscape and the evolving interests of our students. Our proactive approach has equipped our graduates with the necessary skills to both successfully launch and develop their careers over time.

Many of our MSF graduates consistently secure positions in the Financial Services industry. In 2023, we saw growth in this sector with 43% of graduates accepting roles, up 3 percentage points since 2022. Other strong industries for our MSF graduates include Consulting (26%), Real Estate (6%), Energy (6%), Transportation (6%), and Manufacturing (4%). MSF graduates are securing functional area roles in Corporate Finance (34%), Consulting (23%), Banking (19%), and Investment (15%) across these industries, demonstrating the comprehensive skills, interests, and adaptability of our students.

Geographically, the majority of our Texas MSF graduates, 80%, are opting to stay in the Southwest region, working in major Texas cities. Additionally, 6% of graduates relocated to the Northeast, with others also securing opportunities in the Midwest and West.

We have continued to invest in growing the MSF employer ecosystem, and that investment is paying dividends with new opportunities. Notably, 69% of MSF 2023 graduates secured offers from school-facilitated resources, reflecting our students' achievements and the strength of our ecosystem.

The MSF class of 2023 exemplifies the program's ability to prepare graduates for a dynamic and evolving job market, equipping them with skills that are sought after in various industries and regions. As our alumni base grows, so does our network of employers. We look forward to continuing to cultivate partnerships and expanding opportunities for future MSF students.



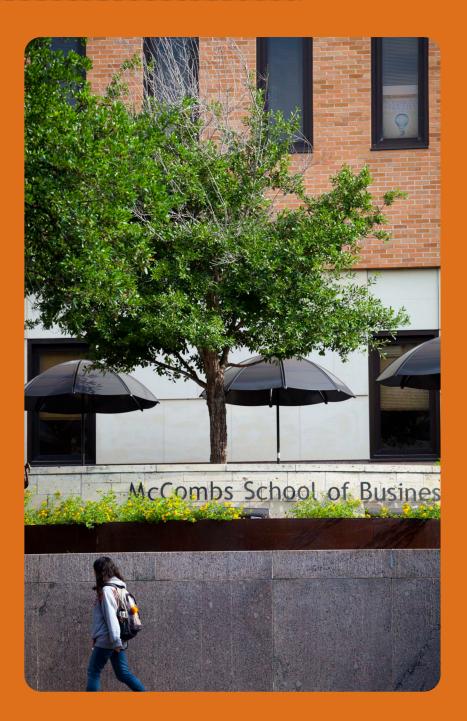
